Bring to share:

- Special greens: variegated euonymus, nandina, English laurel, magnolia leaves, beauty berry, holly, sage, bay leaves, lichen...
- Pinecones, pods, embellishments, sparkly things
- Cookies or other seasonal goodies

Bring for your creations – wreaths, swags, centerpieces:

- Wreath rings (single, double metal, or grapevine), jars or vases
- Florist wire (and picks or florist tape if you use them)
- Your own special greens, embellishments, ribbon, etc.
- Clippers for greens, snips for wire, scissors for ribbon and fine elements
- Gloves

Extras:

- Kathi Tucker will have a Dremel drill press ready to drill holes in your BCMGA badge if you need it to attach hours or position bars.
- Kathy Clark will have several potted red amaryllis for sale to benefit Friends of Benton Gardeners.

***Getting there:** Enter the fairgrounds from NW 53rd street near the RV park, go past the fairground office. When you park, make sure not to block the access to the RV dump station! Heads up - traffic on NW 53rd is dense after about 4:30 pm.
