

Landscaping Without Irrigation in the Willamette Valley

At the BCMGA meeting on Monday evening, February 15 at 7 PM, Neil Bell will talk about reasons to develop a landscape which is not irrigated in the summer-dry climate of the Willamette Valley. He will discuss how to assess your landscape for any issues that you may need to consider or address to meet this goal. He will also describe woody and herbaceous plants which will provide year-round interest in this no or low water garden situation.

Neil is the Community Horticulturist for the OSU Extension Service in Marion and Polk counties. Since 2000 he has overseen Master Gardener programs in both counties. He also helps coordinate Northwest Plant Evaluations, a research program that evaluates plants for un-irrigated landscapes in the Willamette Valley.
